The Embassy has further the honour to inform that, for those who would like to apply for the aforesaid scholarships could visit the Saudi Ministry of Education's website via "www.moe.gov.sa". The scholarships in the Saudi universities grant the students various privileges including the following:

- a. Health care for him and his/her family member (if they are living with him).
- b. Two months' worth of processing allowance will be paid upon arrival.
- c. Three months' fees as graduation allowance for shipping the books.
- d. The student enjoys the same privileges that are granted to his counterparts in the same educational institution.
- e. The educational institution provides cheap meals for the student.
- f. Provision of housing and an appropriate scientific, social, cultural and training care.
- g. Providing tickets, which stipulated in the financial regulations of the educational institution.

The Embassy hopes the esteemed Ministry could convey the above information to the Malaysian relevant authorities.
